Who was St. Jean de Brebeuf?

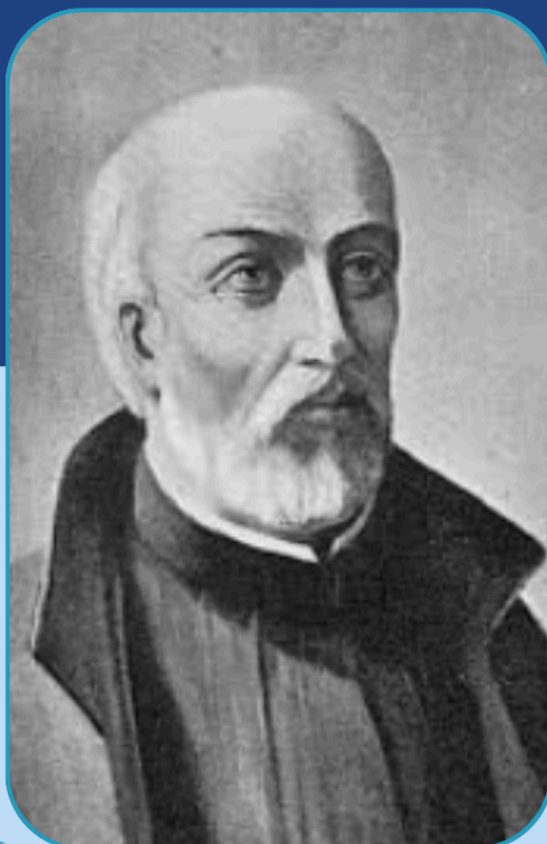
